Common Data Set Definitions

- All definitions related to the financial aid section appear at the end of the Definitions document.
- Items preceded by an asterisk (*) represent definitions agreed to among publishers which do not appear on the CDS document.
- Additional guidance for some terms, particularly those common with the IPEDS survey, may be found here: <https://survey.ipeds.org/>
- *Academic advisement:** Plan under which each student is assigned to a faculty member or a trained adviser, who, through regular contact, monitors the student's progress and provides guidance.
- Accelerated program:** Completion of a college program of study in fewer than the usual number of years, most often by attending summer sessions.
- Admitted student:** Applicant who is offered admission to a degree-granting program at your institution.
- *Adult student services:** Admission assistance, support, orientation, and other services expressly for adults who have started college.
- American Indian or Alaska Native:** A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America (including Central and South America).
- Applicant (first-time, first year):** An individual who has fulfilled the institution's requirements to be considered for admission (including transfer students).
- Application fee:** That amount of money that an institution charges for processing a student's application for acceptance. This amount may vary by institution.
- Asian:** A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent, including, for example, Chinese, Indian, Japanese, Korean, Filipino, Vietnamese, and Thai.
- Associate degree:** An award that normally requires at least two but less than four years of full-time equivalent college work.
- Bachelor's degree:** An award (baccalaureate or equivalent degree, as determined by the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Education).
- Black or African American:** A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.
- Board (charges):** Assume average cost for 19 meals per week or the maximum meal plan.
- Books and supplies (costs):** Average cost of books and supplies. Do not include unusual costs for special groups of students (e.g., engineering).
- Calendar system:** The method by which an institution structures most of its courses for the academic year.
- Campus Ministry:** Religious student organizations (denominational or nondenominational) devoted to fostering religious life on campus.
- *Career and placement services:** A range of services, including (often) the following: coordination of visits of employers to campus; job development; job placement; and career counseling.
- Carnegie units:** One year of study or the equivalent in a secondary school subject.
- Certificate:** See Postsecondary award, certificate, or diploma.
- Class rank:** The relative numerical position of a student in his or her graduating class, calculated by the high school on the basis of standardized test scores and high school grades.
- College-preparatory program:** Courses in academic subjects (English, history and social studies, foreign languages, mathematics, science).
- Common Application:** The standard application form distributed by the National Association of Secondary School Principals for a large number of colleges and universities.
- *Community service program:** Referral center for students wishing to perform volunteer work in the community or participate in volunteer activities.
- Commuter:** A student who lives off campus in housing that is not owned by, operated by, or affiliated with the college. This category includes students who live in off-campus housing owned by the institution but do not receive financial aid from the institution.
- Comprehensive transition and postsecondary program for students with intellectual disabilities:** Programs designed to support postsecondary education for students with intellectual disabilities.
- Clock hour:** A unit of measure that represents an hour of scheduled instruction given to students. Also referred to as contact hour.
- Continuous basis (for program enrollment):** A calendar system classification that is used by institutions that enroll students at any time during the year.
- Cooperative education program:** A program that provides for alternate class attendance and employment in business, industry, or government.
- Cooperative housing:** College-owned, -operated, or -affiliated housing in which students share food and housing expenses and participate in the management of the housing.
- *Counseling service:** Activities designed to assist students in making plans and decisions related to their education, career, or personal development.
- Credit:** Recognition of attendance or performance in an instructional activity (course or program) that can be applied by a recipient toward the number of courses required for achieving a degree.
- Credit course:** A course that, if successfully completed, can be applied toward the number of courses required for achieving a degree.
- Credit hour:** A unit of measure representing an hour (50 minutes) of instruction over a 15-week period in a semester or trimester system.
- Cross-registration:** A system whereby students enrolled at one institution may take courses at another institution without having to be formally admitted to that institution.
- Deferred admission:** The practice of permitting admitted students to postpone enrollment, usually for a period of one academic term.
- Degree:** An award conferred by a college, university, or other postsecondary education institution as official recognition for the successful completion of a program of study.
- Degree-seeking students:** Students enrolled in courses for credit who are recognized by the institution as seeking a degree or recognized as degree-seeking.
- *Developmental services:** Instructional courses designed for students deficient in the general competencies necessary for a regular program of study.
- Differs by program (calendar system):** A calendar system classification that is used by institutions that have occupational/vocational programs.
- Diploma:** See Postsecondary award, certificate, or diploma.
- Distance learning:** An option for earning course credit at off-campus locations via cable television, internet, satellite classes, videotape, or other electronic means.
- Doctor's degree-research/scholarship:** A Ph.D. or other doctor's degree that requires advanced work beyond the master's level, including original research or scholarship.
- Doctor's degree-professional practice:** A doctor's degree that is conferred upon completion of a program providing the knowledge and skills necessary for professional practice.
- Doctor's degree-other:** A doctor's degree that does not meet the definition of a doctor's degree - research/scholarship or a doctor's degree - professional practice.

Double major: Program in which students may complete two undergraduate programs of study simultaneously.

Dual enrollment: Refers to high school students enrolled in college courses for credit. In accordance with IPEDS, student performance is reported as credit earned.

Early action plan: An admission plan that allows students to apply and be notified of an admission decision well in advance of the regular admission plan.

Early admission: A policy under which students who have not completed high school are admitted and enroll full time in college, usually during the summer.

Early decision plan: A plan that permits students to apply and be notified of an admission decision (and financial aid offer if applicable) before the regular admission plan.

English as a Second Language (ESL): A course of study designed specifically for students whose native language is not English.

Exchange student program-domestic: Any arrangement between a student and a college that permits study for a semester or more at a college in another part of the United States.

External degree program: A program of study in which students earn credits toward a degree through independent study, college courses, or other means.

Extracurricular activities (as admission factor): Special consideration in the admissions process given for participation in both school and community activities.

First-time student: A student attending any institution for the first time at the level enrolled. Includes students enrolled in the fall term of the first year.

First-time, first-year student: A student attending any institution for the first time at the undergraduate level. Includes students enrolled in the fall term of the first year.

First-year student: A student who has completed less than the equivalent of 1 full year of undergraduate work; that is, less than 30 semester credits.

Food and housing (charges)—on campus: Assume double occupancy in institutional housing and 19 meals per week (or maximum number of meals per week as reported by the institution).

Full-time student (undergraduate): A student enrolled for 12 or more semester credits, 12 or more quarter credits, or 24 or more clock hours per semester.

Geographical residence (as admission factor): Special consideration in the admission process given to students from a particular region or country.

Grade-point average (academic high school GPA): The sum of grade points a student has earned in secondary school divided by the number of credits earned.

Graduate student: A student who holds a bachelor's or equivalent, and is taking courses at the post-baccalaureate level.

***Health services:** Free or low cost on-campus primary and preventive health care available to students.

High school diploma or recognized equivalent: A document certifying the successful completion of a prescribed secondary school program.

Hispanic or Latino: A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

Honors program: Any special program for very able students offering the opportunity for educational enrichment, independent study, or other special opportunities.

Independent study: Academic work chosen or designed by the student with the approval of the department concerned, under an instructor's supervision.

In-state tuition: The tuition charged by institutions to those students who meet the state's or institution's residency requirements.

International student: See Nonresident.

International student group: Student groups that facilitate cultural dialogue, support a diverse campus, assist international students, and provide other services.

Internship: Any short-term, supervised work experience usually related to a student's major field, for which the student earns academic credit.

***Learning center:** Center offering assistance through tutors, workshops, computer programs, or audiovisual equipment in reading, writing, or other areas.

***Legal services:** Free or low cost legal advice for a range of issues (personal and other).

Liberal arts/career combination: Program in which a student earns undergraduate degrees in two separate fields, one in a liberal arts field and one in a career field.

Living learning community: Residential programs that allow students to interact with students who share common interests. In addition, these communities often provide academic and other support services.

Master's degree: An award that requires the successful completion of a program of study of generally one or two full-time equivalent years.

Minority affiliation (as admission factor): Special consideration in the admission process for members of designated racial/ethnic minorities.

***Minority student center:** Center with programs, activities, and/or services intended to enhance the college experience of students of color.

Model United Nations: A simulation activity focusing on conflict resolution, globalization, and diplomacy. Assuming roles as foreign representatives of various countries.

Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.

***New student orientation:** Orientation addressing the academic, social, emotional, and intellectual issues involved in beginning college.

Nonresident: A person who is not a citizen or national of the United States and who is in this country on a visa or temporary basis.

***On-campus day care:** Licensed day care for students' children (usually age 3 and up); usually for a fee.

Open admission: Admission policy under which virtually all secondary school graduates or students with GED equivalency diplomas are admitted.

Other expenses (costs): Include average costs for clothing, laundry, entertainment, medical (if not a required fee), and furnishings.

Out-of-state tuition: The tuition charged by institutions to those students who do not meet the institution's or state's residency requirements.

Outside a dual enrollment program: High school students who simply enroll in credit courses through your institution, and are treated as regular students.

Part-time student (undergraduate): A student enrolled for fewer than 12 credits per semester or quarter, or fewer than 24 clock hours per semester.

Permanent Resident or other eligible non-citizen: A person who is not a citizen or national of the United States and who has been admitted to the United States for permanent residence.

***Personal counseling:** One-on-one or group counseling with trained professionals for students who want to explore personal, educational, or career issues.

Post-baccalaureate certificate: An award that requires completion of an organized program of study requiring 18 credit hours beyond the bachelor's degree.

Post-master's certificate: An award that requires completion of an organized program of study of 24 credit hours beyond the master's degree.

Postsecondary award, certificate, or diploma: Includes the following three IPEDS definitions for postsecondary awards, certificates, or diplomas: a certificate or diploma that requires completion of a program of study requiring 12 or more semester credits, 12 or more quarter credits, or 24 or more clock hours; a certificate or diploma that requires completion of a program of study requiring 18 or more semester credits, 18 or more quarter credits, or 36 or more clock hours; and a certificate or diploma that requires completion of a program of study requiring 24 or more semester credits, 24 or more quarter credits, or 48 or more clock hours.

Less Than 1 Academic Year: Requires completion of an organized program of study at the postsecondary level (below the baccalaureate level).

At Least 1 But Less Than 2 Academic Years: Requires completion of an organized program of study at the postsecondary level (below the baccalaureate level).

At Least 2 But Less Than 4 Academic Years: Requires completion of an organized program of study at the postsecondary level (below the baccalaureate level).

Private institution: An educational institution controlled by a private individual(s) or by a nongovernmental agency, usually supported by private contributions.

Private for-profit institution: A private institution in which the individual(s) or agency in control receives compensation, other than the payment of a salary.

Private nonprofit institution: A private institution in which the individual(s) or agency in control receives no compensation, other than the payment of a salary.

Proprietary institution: See Private for-profit institution.

Public institution: An educational institution whose programs and activities are operated by publicly elected or appointed school officials.

Quarter calendar system: A calendar system in which the academic year consists of three sessions called quarters of about 12 weeks each.

Race/ethnicity: Category used to describe groups to which individuals belong, identify with, or belong in the eyes of the community.

Race/ethnicity unknown: Category used to classify students or employees whose race/ethnicity is not known and whom institutions do not wish to identify.

Recognized Postsecondary Credential: Includes both Title IV eligible degrees, certificates, and other recognized postsecondary credentials.

Religious affiliation/commitment (as admission factor): Special consideration given in the admission process for affiliation with a certain religion.

***Religious counseling:** One-on-one or group counseling with trained professionals for students who want to explore religious problems.

Required fees: Fixed sum charged to students for items not covered by tuition and required of such a large proportion of all students that it is considered a regular charge.

Secondary school record (as admission factor): Information maintained by the secondary school that may include such things as the student's grade point average, standardized test scores, and other information.

Semester calendar system: A calendar system that consists of two semesters during the academic year with about 16 weeks for each semester.

Student-designed major: A program of study based on individual interests, designed with the assistance of an adviser.

Study abroad: Any arrangement by which a student completes part of the college program studying in another country. Can be at the college or in another country.

***Summer session:** A summer session is shorter than a regular semester and not considered part of the academic year. It is not the traditional summer session.

Talent/ability (as admission factor): Special consideration given to students with demonstrated talent/abilities in areas of interest to the institution.

Teacher certification program: Program designed to prepare students to meet the requirements for certification as teachers in elementary or secondary schools.

Transfer applicant: An individual who has fulfilled the institution's requirements to be considered for admission (including payment of application fee).

Transfer student: A student entering the institution for the first time but known to have previously attended a postsecondary institution.

Transportation (costs): Assume two round trips to student's hometown per year for students in institutional housing or daily travel.

Trimester calendar system: An academic year consisting of 3 terms of about 15 weeks each.

Tuition: Amount of money charged to students for instructional services. Tuition may be charged per term, per course, or per credit hour.

***Tutoring:** May range from one-on-one tutoring in specific subjects to tutoring in an area such as math, reading, or writing. Most tutoring is done on a voluntary basis.

Unit: a standard of measurement representing hours of academic instruction (e.g., semester credit, quarter credit, clock hour).

Undergraduate: A student enrolled in a four- or five-year bachelor's degree program, an associate degree program, or a vocational program.

Unduplicated Count of High School Students Enrolled for Credit include all high school students enrolled in college courses for credit.

Undergraduate Research: Opportunities offered to undergraduate students to make original contributions in an academic discipline.

***Veteran's counseling:** Helps veterans and their dependents obtain benefits for their selected program and provides certifications to the VA.

***Visually impaired:** Any person whose sight loss is not correctable and is sufficiently severe as to adversely affect educational performance.

Volunteer work (as admission factor): Special consideration given to students for activity done on a volunteer basis (e.g., tutoring, holding office, etc.).

Wait list: List of students who meet the admission requirements but will only be offered a place in the class if space becomes available.

Weekend college: A program that allows students to take a complete course of study and attend classes only on weekends.

White: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa.

Within a dual enrollment program: Program within an organized system with special guidelines that allows high school students to take college courses for credit.

***Women's center:** Center with programs, academic activities, and/or services intended to promote an understanding of the evolving role of women.

Work experience (as admission factor): Special consideration given to students who have been employed prior to application, whether or not related to the field of study.

Financial Aid Definitions

External scholarships and grants: Scholarships and grants received from outside (private) sources that students bring with them (e.g., from parents, friends, etc.).

Financial aid applicant: Any applicant who submits any one of the institutionally required financial aid applications/forms, such as

Indebtedness: Aggregate dollar amount borrowed through any loan program (federal, state, subsidized, unsubsidized, private, etc.;

Institutional scholarships and grants: Endowed scholarships, annual gifts and tuition funded grants for which the institution determines

Financial need: As determined by your institution using the federal methodology and/or your institution's own standards.

Need-based aid: College-funded or college-administered award from institutional, state, federal, or other sources for which a student

Need-based scholarship or grant aid: Scholarships and grants from institutional, state, federal, or other sources for which a student

Need-based self-help aid: Loans and jobs from institutional, state, federal, or other sources for which a student must demonstrate financial

Non-need-based scholarship or grant aid: Scholarships and grants, gifts, or merit-based aid from institutional, state, federal, or other

Note: Suggested order of precedence for counting non-need money as need-based:

1. Non-need institutional grants
2. Non-need tuition waivers
3. Non-need athletic awards
4. Non-need federal grants
5. Non-need state grants
6. Non-need outside grants
7. Non-need student loans
8. Non-need parent loans
9. Non-need work

Non-need-based self-help aid: Loans and jobs from institutional, state, or other sources for which a student need not demonstrate financial

Work study and employment: Federal and state work study aid, and any employment packaged by your institution in financial aid :
